Cyclone Biparjoy impacts the APM Terminals Pipavav port operations adversely. Update III – Resumption of Land Side operations

Dear Valued Customers,

Further to our Trade Advisory dated 12th June 2023, we see a considerable improvement in the weather conditions in around Pipavav Port. Thus, we are commencing the following land side operations with immediate effect

- Complete Rail and Yard Operations
- Import delivery of laden and empty containers
- Export gate in of reefers containers only
- Urgent gate in for dry units – pls contact customer care at the port for the same

While marine and quay side operations continue to remain suspended, the port is continuously monitoring the situation and aims to commence marine and quay operations as soon as it satisfies itself of the working condition that ensures safety of vessel, crew, cargo, port infrastructure and all associated personnel.

We shall endeavour to keep all progressively updated and request all agents to notify the port of the revised ETA's of their vessels.
