Sub: Advisory on international arrivals in the context of New Variants of Covid

Ref: D.O.Letter No.Z28015 /182/2021-DM cell dated 29.12.2022

As per the reference cited the GOI has issued the guidelines for international arrivals. In view of this the following guidelines are issued in addition to the present guidelines, for strict compliance.

1. The ships arriving within 14 days of departure from the High-Risk countries (China, Singapore, Hong-Kong, Republic of Korea, Thailand, and Japan) or crew of above countries joining in any other country should submit the Crew List, Port of call List, temperature Log record of 14 days, Medical Log, Maritime declaration of Health, Covid Vaccination status, declaration by master that crew are free of covid symptoms & information on crew sign off, well in advance. The shipping/Steamer agents should coordinate with the vessels and see that the information is provided through mail (phokrishnapatnam@gmail.com).
2. After complying with the SOP such ships will be permitted to berth.
3. All the Boarding Authorities, Shipping agents, staff working on jetties & stevedores working on vessels are advised to follow Infection Prevention and Control measures such as wearing N-95 masks, Surgical Gloves, maintaining hand hygiene & Social distancing.
4. The Port authorities should restrict the boarding persons. No visitors shall be allowed to board the vessel.
5. Embarkation crew from the high risk countries should submit the recent Negative RT-PCR test report from ICMR certified lab irrespective of their vaccination status.

6. Dis-embarkation crew coming from the High Risk countries should undergo RT-PCR test and submit the report for clearing for disembarkation. Disembarked crew with negative RT-PCR report should self-monitor their health for 14 days in case of Indian nationals and till departure in case of foreign nationals. They shall report to their nearest Health facility if they develop any symptoms suggestive of COVID-19. The same may be intimated to the PHO Krishnapatnam port in order to monitor the remaining crew who are onboard. Positive persons will be quarantined in the nearest Covid Health facility/designated Hotel/CCC till they become negative. The Shipping agents shall look after the testing & other treatment care for the crew.
7. All the administrative, Security and other staff working in the Port premises shall wear masks at all times, maintain hand hygiene, should carry personal sanitiser and maintain Social distancing until further instructions.
